





2025 Entrepreneur of the Year

Ida's Vision Bv Bernard Kruchak

Every morning, Ida Albo wakes up enwrapped in the rich cultural history of Winnipeg's Fort Garry Hotel. The managing partner of the 112-year-old Broadway landmark is also a resident, which creates a lifestyle that braids her work, personal, and social lives. For Ida, a scion of an Italian immigrant family, her current domestic circumstances are a full-circle experience.

"My parents, Frank and Marfisia, emigrated from Italy in the late 1950s and met and married in Winnipeg." Ida explains. "Parents, children, and extended family all lived communally above the family grocery store in central Winnipeg. Our family and work life in those days entwined, so there's something poetic about my life now."

Ida's business success story is well-known in Canada. In 1994, Ida and Rick Bel were hard at work running Prairie Oyster Cafe at The Forks and the Fort Garry's food and beverage operation when the hotel's out-of-province owners approached them to become part-owners and dayto-day managers of the property.

Ida recalls the early days of managing the hotel as a "real-life Fawlty Towers," with a lot of sweat equity and the patient investment of their Quebec-based partners. With financial hurdles cleared and extensive renovations completed, today's 236-room Fort Garry Hotel reflects the Gran Dama that opened as a bejewelled railway hotel in 1913.

"The hotel is a national, provincial, and municipal historic site, so we're obligated to protect and maintain certain exterior

and interior features, including the main lobby and rotunda, the grand Crystal and Concert Hall Ballrooms on the seventh floor along with the foyer and loggia, and the main-floor Oval Room and Provencher Ballroom," says Ida. "We've worked hard to restore the renowned glory of the hotel."

If vision is the essence of entrepreneurship, Ida has been clear-eyed about growing the business and making it relevant for 21st-century guests and the community. Now branded The Fort Garry Hotel. Spa and Conference Centre. the property features a variety of meeting and event spaces and a world-class wellness amenity called Ten Spa. The hotel also boasts a fine dining room called Vida Cucina Italia, Sunday evening jazz concerts, and Yuk Yuk's Comedy Club. The Sunset Terrace serves food and drinks outdoors throughout the summer. And just down the road. Yoga Public, Canada's largest yoga studio, offers hotel guests and Winnipeggers an opportunity to participate in various restorative wellness experiences.

"Beyond being a vibrant business, the Fort Garry Hotel is still one of Winnipeg's historical treasures. It's an opportunity to showcase the building's grand history," Ida says. "It's also a responsibility: our entire management team supports many non-profit fundraisers and community events."

lda's business and community service achievements have earned her many accolades, including the Order of Canada, Manitoba Business Hall of Fame honours, and an honorary doctorate from the University of Winnipeg. Still, the Entrepreneur of the Year award from the Canadian Italian Business and Professional Association is unique because it comes from her peers in the Italian community. She shares the honour with her family children Marfisia and Sebastian and her sisters. Pina and Belinda. and brother Frank and their families.

'We're a close family that became stronger after our parents passed away," Ida recalls. "Because of their support, we all have an entrepreneurial spirit."

As the daughter of immigrants, Ida believes heritage is vital to weaving Winnipeg's cultural fabric. So, too, is preserving and promoting the city's history. As managing partner of the Fort Garry Hotel, she lives that credo every day.
